2022 Scholarship Program

The Killmon Foundation announces the 2022 **Scholarship Awards Program**. Under the Program, scholarships will be awarded to seniors demonstrating a passion for serving their country and community. JROTC members will have priority, but all seniors considering a military or community service career will be considered.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors with JROTC membership and/or record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must plan to enlist in the military and/or attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid **directly to the student**, upon receiving a verification of military enlistment OR certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be received in accordance with the school's scholarship program deadlines (**February 28, 2022**) Late applications will not be accepted.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the Killmon Foundation Scholarship Committee. The scholarships will be awarded **May 18, 2022** during the Senior Honors Recognition night.
